I've often imagined how much faster I'd work if sale cattle were actually milling around my office, waiting for their turns to get onto a page! It's always our good fortune that Madeline has an uncanny "rainman" talent for tag numbers and pedigrees. (Go ahead and test her, but don't bet any \$\$\$!) Names and numbers are the vehicles this industry gets around in. The pedigree tells us how an animal got here; the numbers tell us where they are going. It's interesting to me that if we were to tabulate pedigrees of our four "greats," Mary Ann would be relegated way back to the third generation, and these kids would be seen as "stemming" from her rather than surrounding her with love. We are grateful for the time they have with Nanny, sharing her love for the ranch!

We should respect the prefixes in names, because prefixes are PEOPLE. The abbreviations represent relationships with people who envision and create, invest and risk, try and fail, and keep trying 'til they reach their success. I remember hearing it said around a table about 20 years ago, "This is the only business we've ever been in where our competitor is also our customer." People make it complicated, but they also make the Angus business interesting, challenging, and fun. My dad often said: "It's not about the cows, it's about the people." Our family's good relationships with Angus people have kept us in business for well over 45 years!

When you think about WHY you got in the Angus business, also remember WHO. Who introduced you to Angus, encouraged you, mentored you, and helped you along the way? You carry their knowledge and their passion as you create new relationships, set goals and work to achieve your success. When U.S. soldiers arrived to establish Fort Smith in 1817, a rock shelf carved out by the Arkansas and Poteau Rivers is where they touched shore. The French explorers of the Louisiana Purchase had named this spot, at the confluence of the two rivers, "Belle Point" meaning "beautiful place." It was a perfect site, a piece of high ground with access to water that was as functional and efficient as it was scenic. Our business office is adjacent to the point where the soldiers landed, what is now the popular tourist attraction Fort Smith National Historic Site. Mary Ann and David McMahon, Sr. renamed our family company as an homage to our hometown history, and as an inspiration to create a beautiful, growing, thriving company. The name Belle Point naturally extended to the ranch when it was purchased in 1975. You see, the French had also named the creek that the highway crosses just a mile east of the ranch "Vache Grasse" which translates to "fat cow," and the name of our our town was likely adopted from the Spanish explorers of this region. "La Vaca" means "the cow!" It's historical, cultural confirmation that CATTLE have always thrived on this BEAUTIFUL PLACE!
